ELIGIBILITY: Students must have completed their sophomore year by Summer of 2003. Course prerequisites include completion of Animal Sciences 100, Biology 104, or Equivalent. Enrollment or planned enrollment in Animal Sciences 207 is encouraged but not required. Applications are available in room 116 and are due by December 21st, 2002. Decisions will be made in early February, 2003.

The internships vary in terms of credit hours earned and monetary compensation offered.
